#### Partnerships Thrive at Twin Towers



College-Conservatory of Music

The University of Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music (CCM) and Twin Towers introduced the Artists-in-Residence program at Twin Towers – the first of its kind in southwest Ohio.

Through this collaboration, two CCM graduate students receive free housing for the duration of their degree programs in exchange for monthly recitals and unprecedented interaction with residents through discussions and open rehearsals.

This partnership is an extension of the college's ongoing community engagement activities throughout Greater Cincinnati, providing a tremendous tool to recruit the best students while giving them much-needed financial resources to reduce the cost of graduate school while engaging with and learning from Twin Towers' residents.

Twin Towers Executive Director Jim Lay explains, "The benefits of this new partnership are equally noteworthy for our residents by providing them with an opportunity for meaningful relationships with talented and inspirational young people who aspire to reach lifelong goals. For the artists themselves, it is a chance for Twin Towers to assist these students in achieving their career dreams by easing the path to reach those goals while also opening doors to new and supportive relationships."

The program has been a great success and Twin Towers looks forward to the arrival of two additional students in the Fall Semester 2016.



Hospice of Cincinnati (HOC) at Twin Towers is a collaboration that brought two esteemed organizations together to provide compassionate

and meaningful end-of-life care to families on Cincinnati's West Side.

The 13-bed inpatient hospice unit which opened in the Twin Towers Health Pavilion in July, 2015 replaced the space Hospice of Cincinnati occupied at the former Mercy Hospital building in Westwood.

"Our shared mission and vision for the highest quality care will be evident through this unique partnership," said HOC President and CEO, Sandra Lobert. "We are committed to the West Side and this move provides a quality inpatient care setting where our award-winning staff will care for patients nearing the end of life."

This new relationship increases positive community exposure for Twin Towers and supports the focus on deepening the quality of services provided for the residents.

#### Twin Lakes Master Plan Takes Shape

Throughout 2015, the Master Planning Team, including Twin Lakes/LEC leadership, CR architecture+design and Danis Building Construction, worked diligently to provide greater clarity to the expansion of Twin Lakes and renovation of the existing Assisted Living and Nursing Areas.

To address the growing demand for services, the Main Campus plan includes the addition of 45 independent living apartments, additional parking, the Shirley M. Davies Community Center and a casual dining venue. The North Campus plan includes additional villas and Memory Support Assisted Living accommodations that will offer two distinct programs based on an individuals' level of cognitive impairment.

The former Honda building was demolished in 2015 making way for the expansion project. Construction is expected to begin in summer 2016 with an estimated completion in late 2017.



# Life Enriching Communities Joins Caring Communities Insurance Company

Life Enriching Communities (LEC) joined Caring Communities, a Reciprocal Risk Retention Group in 2015, which provides customized insurance protection to meet emerging risks facing the senior care industry. Under this agreement, LEC has purchased professional, general and umbrella liability policies from Caring Communities and will also have access to insurance group purchasing for specialty property and auto insurance as well as group health. Through this membership, LEC has access to research and evidence-based practices for providing care and services to its residents thereby enhancing its culture of safety and risk management.

Not-for-profit and mission driven, Caring Communities members are leaders in the senior housing and services industry who share a common goal—to provide quality care, a safe working environment, and an optimal lifestyle and safe living for those they serve.

"Life Enriching Communities is very enthusiastic about our association with Caring Communities," says LEC President and CEO Scott McQuinn. "We place significant value on Caring Communities' risk management platform which will be integral to our quality assurance and continuous improvement processes.

#### Post-Acute Care Network, One Year Later

In early 2015, the Post-Acute Care Network, LLC was launched as a partnership between LEC and Episcopal Retirement Services. The initial major initiative was to take part in a federal healthcare reform pilot program called Bundled Payments for Care Improvement (BPCI). The goal of the BPCI is to provide better, more coordinated care for seniors as they leave the hospital and continue their recovery, both in skilled nursing facilities and then at home.

The Post-Acute Care Network, in conjunction with its 11 network members, including Twin Lakes and Twin Towers, implemented patient centric programs, including a unique care transitions program that assists patients as they move from hospital to skilled nursing facility to home. A major component of the care transitions program is the use of a care transitions coordinator who will work with patients and their family members to mutually establish care goals and desired outcomes for the patients. These coordinators follow the patients for 45 days after their admission to the skilled nursing facility. They help patients transition to their homes and make sure medication lists are accurate and that patients are getting to their doctors' appointments.


The results of the care transitions program demonstrate that patients are returning to their homes safely and more quickly. The results also demonstrate that the number of avoidable emergency department visits and the number of times patients are readmitted to the hospital are decreasing. Most importantly, the Post-Acute Care Network's participation in the BPCI, helps its Members provide better care, lower costs and achieve better outcomes.


#### DONATIONS BY PURPOSE TOTAL FOR 2015 - \$1,268,000
