As the fourth generation of the Neyer family to run the business, Don and his brothers worked together from the 1950s to the 1990s, Don was named CEO in 1969. He championed the design-build method Neyer Properties is still famous for.

Don Neyer and his wife Phyllis moved to Twin Lakes in 2012. Don was involved in many projects and work groups and was a true "Friend of Twin Lakes." Don served as the Twin Lakes Resident Representative to the Board and mentored many associates through his honest and practical guidance. While serving on a \$50 million construction project, his background provided the expertise of a construction manager without paying a salary.

Don believed in "service above self" and left a legacy of service to his community. He received many awards for his service, including being named one of *The Greatest Living Cincinnatians* in 2019. However, his greatest service was to his wife of 63 years, Phyllis. He was devoted to her throughout their marriage and then lovingly cared for and advocated for her during her journey with cognitive loss.
