She has navigated every transition with grace—from new executive chefs to menu overhauls to evolving expectations from residents and leadership. Through it all, she has stayed rooted in what matters most: preparing delicious food with love and making people feel at home.

Their connection represents something deeper than teamwork—it’s the kind of bond that forms when someone invests fully in another person’s success, without needing recognition in return.

Kim does this for every new associate, whether they’re a teenager working their first shift or someone exploring a career change. She’s the one they confide in, the one who helps them navigate difficult days, and the one who celebrates their successes with quiet pride. 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Her passion for holistic care and wellness also adds a unique layer to her contribution. Outside of work, Kim is an herbalist. Associates often say that working with Kim is one of the reasons they stay. Her presence gives people a sense of belonging. She is the person you go to when you're unsure. The person who lifts you when you're down. The one who always has your back.
