

LEC and TWC Have Officially Affiliated

Loveland, OH – Senior living community, Life Enriching Communities (LEC) has joined with Columbus, OH-based The Wesley Communities (TWC) as of **May 1st**.

LEC and TWC have been in discussions for several months regarding a full affiliation and as of May 1st, the appropriate documents have been signed. Both boards have approved the arrangement in which TWC becomes an affiliate of LEC reporting up through its organizational structure.

With this expansion comes an additional __ independent living apartments and __ assisted living apartments added to campus with occupancy beginning immediately.

TWC has a 50-year history of providing assisted living, memory care, and nursing care services in the city of Columbus. TWC are independent not-for-profit organizations dedicated to providing excellence in health care.

"One of our strategic initiatives over the last several years has been to proactively pursue affiliations and partnerships within the senior living sector," says Scott McQuinn, President/CEO of LEC.

"The senior living landscape has seen significant consolidation and we believe this will continue. Some of the pressures in the market that are driving this consolidation are the complexities of health care, competition, ability to attract and retain talent, technology, and financial capacity. We are looking forward to working with the team at The Wesley Communities to establish greater efficiencies and effectiveness to benefit the residents and associates of each community."

The organization employs 550 individuals.
